

## **\$0 Free Inspection China Trip on April 1, 2017 or October 5, 2017**

Dear Trip Planners,

Thank you for your interest in our China trip program. I would like to invite you to join our \$0 free inspection China trip, and to share with our successful experiences of China tour operation.

Please find the attached tentative itinerary and the registration form to fill in, and forward it back to me by e-mail reply or send it back by fax to 626-571-7916. The deadline of registration is on January 1, 2017 for April 1 departure, or August 1, 2017 for October 5 departure.

As the a trip planner, you are free to travel in this group, everything on the itinerary is included, such as round trip international air travel with economy class, Chinese domestic air travel, 5-star hotels stay, 3-meal a day, all tour attraction entry expenses on the itinerary, tour bus service and English speaking tour guide service, airport tax and air fuel surcharge, and a post departure travel insurance (for U.S. passport).

If you travel singly, I cover for your single room supplement. If you would like to travel with your spouse or kids or your friends, they pay for their trip with our group travel rate \$1,799 (Los Angeles departure) or \$1,899 (JFK departure) per person, if they need a single room supplement for entire trip, the cost is \$500. Each passenger pay one time tip \$39 for the entire trip in China. The ticketing day is on January 1 (for April 1 departure) or August 1 (for October 5 departure), the paid passengers have to balance for the tour fare before or on the ticketing day, the cancellation penalty for paid passenger after ticketing day is \$500 each, cancellation on or after departure day get no refund.

The visa application package includes your real passport, visa application form (you only need to fill in your last name, first name, date of birth and your signature) one additional passport photo and a check of \$155 payable to Citslinc. You might mail the package by overnight express mail to me any day from now up to your trip departure, I take 10 working days for visa application.

## **FREE INSPECTION TRIP TO CHINA, Oct 5 (or Apr 1) Every Year**

### Day 1 10/5 JFK (or LAX)/Beijing

Check in at JFK International Airport for an afternoon flight CA982 by 4:50pm to Beijing. Your adventure begins as you fly trans-Pacific aboard a wide cabin jetliner. Cross the International Dateline.

### Day 2 10/6 Beijing

(Sheraton Beijing Dongcheng Hotel/5 star, 36 North Third Ring Road East, Dongcheng District, Tel: 0086-10-57988888)

Arrive in Beijing, the Capital of China at 6:20pm. You will be met by your local tour guide at the airport. Transfer to the hotel after dinner.

### Day 3 10/7 Beijing

Visit the Tiananmen Square, the largest square in the world. The Palace Museum, also known as the Forbidden City, home of 24 emperors with a total space of 9,999 rooms. A Hutong tour by rickshaw riding to see the old Beijing. Lunch at local family's house. The Summer Palace, known for the Long Corridor with a painted gallery, Kunming Lake and Longevity Hill, Seventeen- Arch Bridge and Marble Boat. Visit the Pearl Factory. Roasted Beijing Duck Dinner is arranged.

### Day 4 10/8 Beijing

Visit the 2008 Beijing Olympic venues for the outside views of National Stadium the Bird's Nest and the National Aquatic Center. Continue the tour to the Great Wall. The 4,000- mile long and 2,000 years old construction is said to be the only man-made structure visible by the naked eye from the moon. En route visit the Jade Factory. Visit to the Ming Tombs, one of 13 Ming Emperors' Tombs is fully excavated and open for exploration.

### Day 5 10/9 Beijing/Shanghai/Suzhou

(Suzhou Marriott Hotel/5star, 1296 Ganjiang Road West, Jinchang District, Tel: 0086-512-82258888)

Morning flight to Shanghai CA1501 8:30am/10:40am, then take the tour bus trip to Suzhou. Afternoon sightseeing to the Tiger Hill & take a boat ride on Suzhou canals. Visit Suzhou Industrial Zone.

Day 6 10/10 Suzhou/Hangzhou

(Crowne Plaza Hotel Hangzhou Grand Canal/5star, 333 Shangtang Road, Tel:0086-571-88168888)

Morning visit the Suzhou Silk factory. Continue the tour with the centuries old Linger Garden. Afternoon visit to the National Embroidery Institute to see silk embroidery, an important local craft with 1,000 years history. Take a bus riding to Hangzhou.

Day7 10/11 Hangzhou/Shanghai

(Renaissance Shanghai Zhongshan Park Hotel/5star, No.1018 Changning Road, Tel: 0086-21-61158888)

In the morning have a boat ride on West Lake with relaxing stopover at jewel-like pagodas. Visit the Longjing Green Tea Plantation. The centuries old Lingyin Temple, with the main feature of the 64.3 ft-high camphor-wood carved Buddha. Continue the bus journey to Shanghai.

Day 8 10/12 Shanghai

The Bund, a famous waterfront park. Visit the Shanghai Silk Rug Factory. Afternoon enjoy the Yu Garden, a maze of marvelous pavilions, ponds, rocky works and over arching trees. Free time exploration of the old town bazaar. Visit the Pudong District. The amazing Era Show is arranged.

Day 9 10/13 Shanghai/Beijing/JFK (LAX)

In the morning fly to Beijing via CA1858 7:55am/10:15am. Afternoon flight CA981 will depart by 1:00pm for JFK where you will arrive at 2:20pm on the same day.
