




South Blackfoot Interchange Exit 89

The Idaho Transportation Department is developing plans to improve the South Blackfoot Interchange at Exit 89 on Interstate 15. The purpose of the improvements is to:

- Improve safety and mobility for motorists.
- Increase capacity to meet the region's growing traffic needs.
- Modernize aging infrastructure to improve interchange operations.



ANTICIPATED IMPROVEMENTS

The Idaho Transportation Department is evaluating multiple design options for the new interchange. Each option is expected to:

- Lengthen interchange ramps to improve safety.
- Add a dedicated exit lane to improve ramp operations.
- Adjust the interchange to accommodate future additional lanes on I-15.

Gather technical information to help develop preliminary design plans

2024 – 2025

Develop preliminary design plans

2025 – 2027

Develop final design plans

2030

Construct improvements (depending on availability of funds)
