I-15 South Blackfoot Interchange (Exit 89)

This project will replace the South Blackfoot Interchange at Exit 89. Learn about preliminary design options and submit your input.

I-15 US-26/Blackfoot Interchange (Exit 93)

This project will replace the US-26/Blackfoot Interchange at Exit 93. Review planned designs and provide comments to the project team.




I-15 US-26/Blackfoot Interchange (Exit 93)

This project will widen I-15 to three lanes in each direction between the South Blackfoot and the US-26/Blackfoot interchanges (exits 89 and 93). Learn about preliminary design options and provide feedback.
