




# Exit 89 to Exit 93 Widening

The Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) is developing plans to widen I-15 to three lanes in each direction between the South Blackfoot Interchange (Exit 89) and the US-26/Blackfoot Interchange (Exit 93).

The purpose of the project is to improve the safety, mobility and capacity of I-15 within the project area.

### ITD is developing a design that will:

- Widen I-15 to three lanes in each direction.
- Replace the Riverton Road Overpass.
- Replace the I-15 Blackfoot River Bridge.
- Include a smooth transition between this project and the South Blackfoot Interchange (Exit 89) and US-26/Blackfoot Interchange (Exit 93) projects.



## PROCESS AND SCHEDULE

2025	Gather technical information to help develop preliminary design plans
2025–2026	Develop preliminary design plans
2026–2027	Develop final design plans
2027	Construct improvements when funding is identified

## PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT

The project team will provide multiple opportunities for the public to review plans and provide input, including an in-person and virtual public meeting planned for 2026.
