



Statement from the CFR President Regarding NC's COVID-19 Stay at Home Order

March 28, 2020

Yesterday, Governor Roy Cooper issued Executive Order 121 imposing “Stay-at-Home” requirements for all North Carolinians starting Monday, March 30th at 5 pm. Real estate services are allowed to continue if our activity follows health guidelines.
