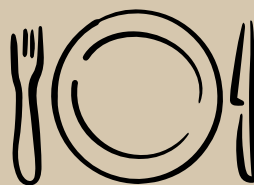
What's Included?

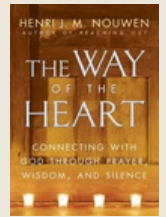
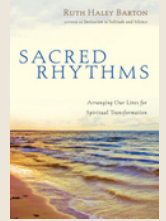
Daily walking distances range from approximately 9-17 miles.

Pre-Camino Book Club

What makes this journey unique is that it begins long before you ever set foot on the Camino. This is not simply a trip—it is a season of spiritual formation. In the months leading up to our walk, you'll be invited into intentional preparation through guided Camino training, spiritual practices, and a pre-pilgrimage book study led by Rev. Sarah Locke. Together, we will begin to slow down, listen for God's voice, and reflect on what it means to walk in the way of Jesus—so that when we arrive in Portugal, we are not just physically ready, but spiritually attentive. By the time the journey begins, you will already be part of a community, already in conversation with God, and ready to experience the Camino as a deeply meaningful and transformative pilgrimage.

FAQ's

What is the Camino?

Since the 9th-century discovery of St. James's tomb in a 'Field of Stars' (Compostela), the ancient Christian pilgrimage to Santiago, Spain, has inspired over a millennium of spiritual reflection and renewal.

What makes this trip different?

This is a pilgrimage, not a vacation. We hope that this pilgrimage will give you time and space to deepen your listening, still your spirit, and grow in your faith.

Who is this for?

This pilgrimage is for those who are longing for space—to reflect, to seek, to grieve, to hope, and to deepen their walk with God.

It is for any woman who feels the need to step away from the pace of everyday life and listen more closely for God's presence.

Do I carry my luggage?

No. Luggage is transferred daily. You only carry a daypack.

Where will we stay?

Comfortable hotels in shared (double) rooms along the route. Single rooms are available for a total cost of \$4024 (not including flights).

What meals are included?

Most breakfasts and 8 dinners. Lunch is on your own during the walk.

How does airfare work?

Flights are not included in the base cost. Hodos Travel Co. will send out an estimate in September and will book in October 2026. You may also book on your own, and Hodos Travel Co. will make timing recommendations.

What if I come alone?

Many do! Community forms quickly, and roommate matching is available.

What if I can't walk a day?

Rest is good, and Hodos Travel Co. will offer support and alternative options as available.

How do I prepare?

Begin walking regularly and participate in the Camino Book Club.

What should I bring?

Good walking shoes, layers, rain gear, a daypack, an open spirit, and a packing guide will be provided in the Fall.
