In 2022, DeCaprio founded the Arazzo Music Festival—an annual chamber music festival focused on bringing free high-caliber concerts and educational events to his home state of Connecticut. DeCaprio holds degrees from UConn, Eastman, Mannes, Yale, and Juilliard.
