Over 732 acres preserved in Colchester!

Gateway II: 14 Acres
Acquired by DEEP in 2008, this property abuts CLT's Gateway property.

Gateway to the Air Line Trail: 18 Acres
Purchased by the CLT in 2007, Gateway has significant frontage on the Air Line Trail, and abuts the Salmon River State Forest.

Day Pond Extension: 59 Acres
In 2015 DEEP acquired this parcel which abuts the existing Day Pond State Park.

River Road Easement: 62 Acres
Currently under forestry and agricultural use, this property is now permanently protected from development according to an easement donated to CLT in 2007.

Meadowbrook Wildlife Management Area: 161 Acres
This DEEP property located off Prospect Hill Road is now permanently preserved.

Meadowbrook Expansion: 108 Acres
DEEP acquisition in 2016, this property adds acreage to the Meadowbrook Wildlife Area.

Bulkeley Hill Preserve: 115 Acres
Purchased through a bargain sale to CLT in 2016. The 200-Acre Capital Campaign is now complete, giving CLT outright ownership.

Bulkeley Hill Road Property: 15 Acres
This 15-acre parcel was deeded to the Colchester Land Trust in 2007. It includes the headwaters to the Eightmile River, which has been identified as a "Wild & Scenic River" by the National Park Service.

Usher Swamp Property: 25 Acres
Deeded to CLT in 2008. Located in the Eight-mile River headwaters, and abuts land owned and managed for open space by the East Haddam Fish & Game Club.

Tangletree Farm: 67 Acres
CLT closed on this easement in May 2017, ensuring that this property will only and always be used agriculturally.

Ruby Cohen Expansion: 31 Acres
In 2009 CLT donated \$42,500 toward the purchase of a 31-acre expansion of the Town-owned Ruby Cohen Woodlands.

McDonald Road Property: 4 Acres
Donated to CLT in 2006, was used as collateral to acquire the Gateway Property in 2007. **52 Additional Acres Deeded to CLT in May 2018.**
