

Don't Forget to License Your Dog

June 1st to June 30th is dog licensing month in the State of Connecticut. The law requires you to license any dog that is 6 months or older. You can obtain your license in the following ways:

- Come into the Town Clerk's Office in person,
- License by mail, be sure to include a stamped, self-addressed envelope, proper documentation and a check made payable to "Town of Colchester".
- On-line on our website at colchesterct.gov/townclerk/pages/dog-licenses.

A Rabies Certificate as well as validation of being spayed or neutered is required at the time of licensing. If you are renewing a license be sure a current rabies certificate is on file with our office. Our Office hours are M-F 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Thursday 8:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

By state law, penalty charges are added if licenses are not renewed by June 30th. The penalty is \$1.00 per month starting July 1, 2024.
