



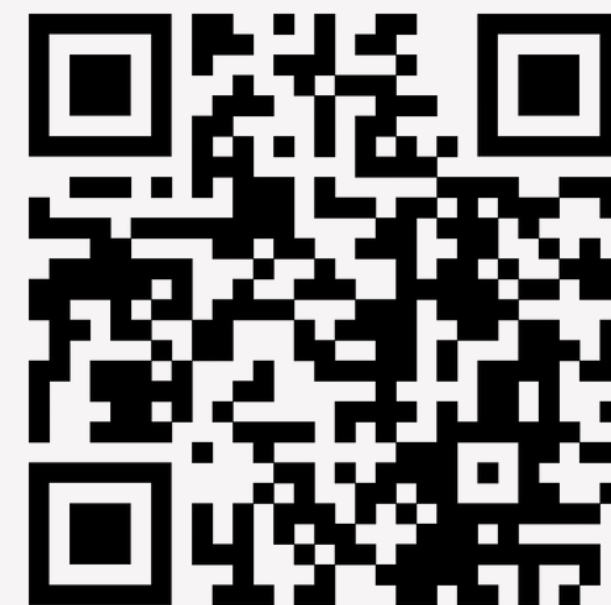
FOOD ASSISTANCE: SOUP KITCHENS

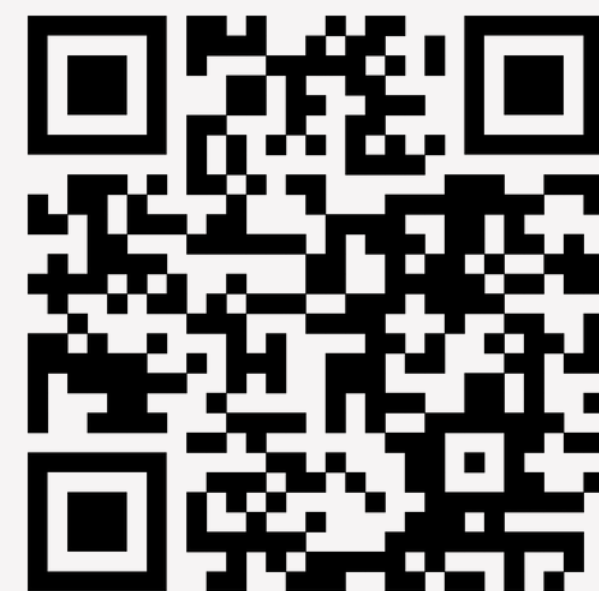
Ste. Anne de Detroit Food Bank at the Basilica
