## Lyceum Guidelines

*Lyceum is for the purpose of enriching the work done in class, by studying quietly, attending tutoring, or other meaningful academic work. Please become familiar with the following guidelines:*

### ***When the Lyceum bell rings:***

1. Students may visit lockers to get any necessary study materials.
2. Then, students should choose a location of study:
  - a. Select a classroom for **tutoring** (*schedule is posted on boards around campus*)  
*Space is limited; students should expect to find an alternate location if their first choice is full.*
  - b. Go to the **Library** for silent study.
  - c. Or go to the **Dining Hall** for quiet group work.  
*Snacks are permitted during middle-school Lyceum. Middle-school students may go to the field if accompanied by a faculty member.*
3. By the end of the passing period, students must be where they expect to spend the full Lyceum period. Students may not switch locations or visit lockers until the end of Lyceum.
4. When the Lyceum bell rings, students will be dismissed back to lockers to prepare for class.
