

Message from Your ACHE Regent Summer 2018

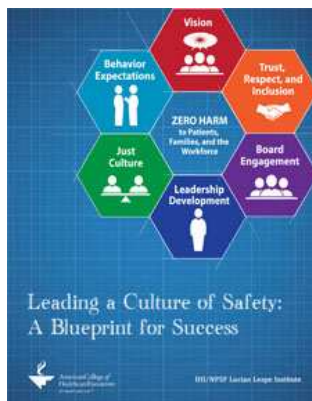
Dear ACHE Colleagues,
