In 2014, Mass General has also received the first-ever [American Hospital Association \(AHA\) Equity of Care Award](#) in recognition of its efforts to reduce health care disparities and promote diversity within the organization's leadership and staff. And most recently, Mass General was recognized as the 2019 Leader in [LGBTQ Healthcare Equality by the Human Rights Campaign \(HRC\)](#).
