These fees provide the remaining funds needed for your Council to operate. These fees support the same type of programs as the Program Fee. The Council spends a little over \$250 per Scout, per year. This assessment is only due from rechartering youth and will be invoiced to units in January. A youth will only pay the assessment one time, even if they are in multiple programs.

Any unit that pays the Good Turn Assessment in full by January 31, 2022 will receive a Scout Shop gift card in February, equivalent to 1% of their assessment. All Good Turn Assessments are otherwise due May 31, 2022.
