Camp RYLA is seeking creative, energetic, accountable Staff Members to provide a safe and memorable experience for campers. The Staff is responsible for leading committees and facilitating leadership-focused activities, discussions, and experiences for campers.

The Staff will be directly accountable for setting up and leading small group activities and committees for all high school age campers for the duration of their week at Camp RYLA. The staff will interact with all campers while outside of their cabin and have a direct impact on the students' leadership development. Members of the staff are responsible for cultivating an inclusive, positive environment where all students feel empowered to share opinions, ideas, and challenges.

- Encourage campers to be involved in each activity
- Facilitate group activities for campers during group activities
- Facilitate small group discussions
- Report any notable concerns or incidents to Camp RYLA Leadership
- Know, enforce, and follow all safety guidelines associated with the camp
- Keep track of camper dietary restrictions, allergies, and health concerns
