#### **Constitutional Amendment**

At its Oct. 24 meeting, the Hosanna Council approved that this amendment be presented to the congregation for addition to the Hosanna Constitution: "C5.05. This congregation shall have a Mission Endowment Fund that will operate as specified in this congregation's bylaws. The purpose of the Mission Endowment Fund is to provide for mission work beyond the operational budget of this congregation." The next step is for the congregation to vote on this proposed amendment at its meeting on Dec. 5. If adopted, bylaws changes will be proposed to specify how the endowment will operate.
