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
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## Overview

Northeast Oregon Area Health Education Center (NEOAHEC) is a non-profit organization established in 1991 as Oregon's first regional health education center. The Area Health Education Center (AHEC) network includes more than 300 program offices and regional centers nationwide, funded by the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA). Congress developed the AHEC program in 1971 to recruit, train, and retain a health professions workforce committed to underserved and rural populations.


