NY ABLE provides eligible individuals with disabilities a better way to save money for today's needs and invest for the future. NY ABLE accounts:

- Do not jeopardize eligibility for most benefit programs.
- Are tax-advantaged, so earnings grow tax free*.
- Can accept contributions from anyone: the account owner, family and friends.
- Funds can be spent anytime on a wide range of qualified disability expenses.

Who is Eligible?

Individuals with a qualifying disability that was present before the age of 26 may be eligible to open an NY ABLE account.
