Step 1. Submit an online form to schedule your ceremony at ISCJ at least a month in advance. Please click here to access the form. Once your form is received, the marriage scheduling coordinator will work on securing the date and confirming availability with you. There are also hard copies of this form available in the ISCJ main office, if you prefer to come in person.

<u>Step 2.</u> Submit the following documents and administrative fees to the ISCJ (Br. Sayed Hassan) administrator at least a week before the scheduled ceremony:

- Marriage Application Form
- > Administrative fee:
 - \$600 for non-members (\$300 check made payable to Imam Hamad Chebli and \$300 check made payable to ISCJ)
 - \$500 for ISCJ members (\$300 check made payable to Imam Hamad Chebli and \$200 made payable to ISCJ)

Step 3. For the day of the nikkah ceremony:

- Provide two witnesses for the nikkah ceremony.
- Also, be sure to bring your marriage license that you have obtained from your local county courthouse.

Step 4. If you plan on serving food (dinner or lunch setup) for your wedding ceremony, please do not forget to indicate so when you fill out the form to schedule your ceremony.

Policy regarding Imam attending an off-site wedding ceremony:

If you would like Imam Hamad Chebli to attend a wedding ceremony that is scheduled off-site, you must contact the main office at (732) 329-6995 to check his availability. Please note there will be an additional \$100/hour travel fee for offsite ceremonies.
