



Dear Ohio Premier Families,

I hope everyone is well. I have an update for our summer 2020 plans. If you have not already seen, the NCAA recently extended their dead period, meaning coaches are NOT allowed to recruit off campus.

(We are currently in Phase 2 (no contact) of the return to play protocols. Below is the plan should we be in phase 3(contact allowed)by July 6. Should we not move to phase 3 by July 6 we will reevaluate our summer format.)

With this information, I felt it was important to make the decision to not attend either the Capital Cup and Champions Cup. This was not a decision made lightly and I tried to weigh all possible options that would lead to a successful recruiting summer season given the current state of athletics.

Not having college coaches in attendance, driving to Virginia and Maryland, for film only- is counterintuitive.

I believe we can better replicate this process locally through filming practice scrimmages and holding a camp at the end of July. (D2 and D3 coaches are allowed, NO D1's allowed)

With that being said, we are moving to a 1 HR skill and 1 HR scrimmage practice for the summer. ALL practices will be filmed with players having access to splice video to be sent to coaches. At the end of the day, college coaches will want to see your daughter play live.

Our summer season will now run from **July 6-July 29** with the same Monday/Wednesday evening practice format. We will provide partial/full refunds depending on the option you select since we are cutting down from 12-8 practices.

We will host a camp on July 25 from 1-4 PM with D1, D2, D3 coaches running the session alongside our Ohio Premier staff. All 2023-2021 age groups are invited.

I appreciate everyone's patience as we navigate through the pandemic. I am hopeful that we will have a successful fall recruiting season and that you continue your commitment to Ohio Premier. I am 100% COMMITTED to our players and providing the best opportunities for them.
