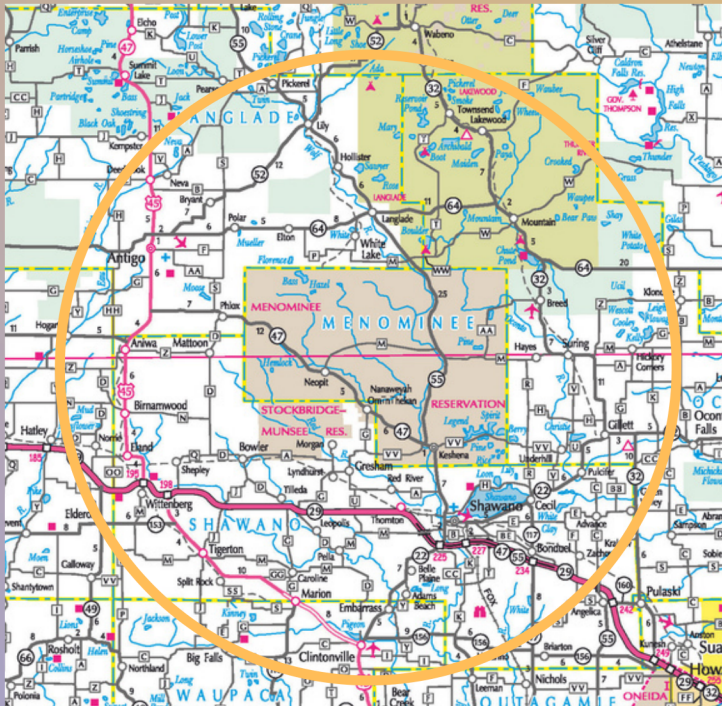




MENOMINEE INDIAN TRIBE OF WISCONSIN

NEW TANF SERVICE AREA



The designated Tribal TANF service area are lands within the exterior boundaries of the Menominee Indian Reservation/County to include the portion of Shawano County known as Middle Village. TANF will serve all qualified individuals within that service area including Tribally enrolled and non-enrolled individuals with proven residency within the defined areas and meeting program eligibility requirements. The defined extended service area is a 15 mile radius of the far (corner) exterior borders of the Menominee Indian Reservation/County and is available only to enrolled members of the Menominee Indian Tribe of Wisconsin or a direct descendent of an enrolled Menominee member with proven residency and meeting program eligibility requirements.

ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

- Biological or court ordered child under 19 residing in your care
- 185% of the Federal Poverty Level income cap
- Resident of the area for the past 30 days

TANF PURPOSE

1) To provide assistance to needy families so that children can be cared for in their own homes or in the homes of relatives; (2) to end the dependence of needy parents on government benefits by promoting job preparation, work, and marriage; (3) to prevent and reduce the incidence of out-of-wedlock pregnancies and establish annual numerical goals for preventing and reducing the incidence of these pregnancies; and (4) to encourage the formation and maintenance of two-parent families.
