YĀCHEHTĀWAK PROGRAM P.A.A.R.I. MODEL (VOLUNTARY PROGRAM)

Pronounced *Ya-chee-tow-ak*,
meaning “Change Their Ways
For The Better”

Our goal is to reduce
substance abuse and the
number of overdose fatalities,
on the Reservation with
Menominee People as well as
to mitigate the impacts on
crime victims by developing a
helping hand to aid those in
need of help and/or treatment.

WHAT TO EXPECT FROM A CRISIS RESPONSE WORKER?

We work with the participant to identify,
evaluate, and advocate for treatment
services relative to the participant’s
needs.

We collaborate with other providers and
agencies, which aids in the process to
provide all the support a participant
needs to reach sobriety goals.

- Coordinate direct assistance for
victims of substance abuse
- Assist participants with their AODA
needs
 - Transportation to AODA
appointments
 - Transportation to and from
Treatment
 - Sober Living

ELIGIBILITY

- If enrolled – participant can live
on or off the Reservation
- If not enrolled – participant
needs to live on the Reservation
- No active warrants
- Cannot be incarcerated
- If under the age of 18 – must
have consent by parent or legal
guardian
- Under Menominee Tribal
Jurisdiction
