Yācehtāwak Program— P.A.A.R.I Model

Pronounced Ya-chee-tow-ak, meaning “They’re making change”. P.A.A.R.I stands for Police Assisted Addiction Recovery Initiative. Our goal is to reduce substance abuse and the number of overdose fatalities, as well as to mitigate the impacts on crime victims within the Menominee Tribal Jurisdiction by developing a helping hand to aid those in need of help and/or treatment.

What is Crisis Response?

The role of the Crisis Response Worker is to provide rapid response services in the event of a crisis surrounding opioid use and the families involved. Help can just be a call away.

Opiate overdose is a leading cause of accidental deaths in Wisconsin. To help reduce the number of fatal and nonfatal overdoses on the reservation, we’re changing the perception of how we handle those individuals that request help with their opioid disorder and other substance abuse.

We work with the participant to identify, evaluate, and advocate for treatment services relative to the participant’s needs.

Collaborating with other providers and agencies aids in the process to provide all the support a participant needs to reach sobriety goals.

What Can a Crisis Response Worker Do for Me?

- ◆ Workers will coordinate direct assistance for victims of substance abuse
- ◆ Address necessities identified in the basic needs assessment and safety plan
- ◆ Be responsible for crisis calls from Law Enforcement and other facilities.
- ◆ Provide emergency services to participants and their families by coordinating with other agencies.
