WBMD Restructuring: Get to know your staff

2022 was a year of district restructuring. Anticipating the retirement of Director Dawn Baxter and Administrative Assistant Jane Renner, your council worked to identify three "Tables" of ministry that connect our 33 congregations: Youth Ministry, Feeding/Food Pantries, Collaboration/Collegiality. In November, the WBMD fall assembly voted to establish a new position of District Coordinator. Your WBMD Council created a job description and interviewed several candidates. Deaconess Deborah Graf began serving on February 1, 2023. Kristen Kelly, Director of Youth and Missions at Allegheny Lutheran Church, was appointed to lead the Youth Table, and began her work with us on March 1.

Dear WBMD congregations and leaders!

I am excited and honored to serve as the Coordinator of the West Berks Mission District. My family and I moved to Berks County in June 1999 when I was called to Trinity Lutheran Church in beautiful downtown, Reading. Besides working with faith formation, mission and service, and other duties as assigned, I was able to serve as a part time Associate of the Bishop from 2009-2011. It was during this time that I got to know so many of the people and congregations in our mission district; I look forward to reconnecting with leaders and worshipping communities.

In February, 2023, our expenses exceeded income by \$300.

The General Fund checkbook balance at the end of February was about \$29,500.

In mid-March the mortgage balance stands at \$22,560 and the Debt Reduction Fund has a balance of \$19,298 to pay down on the principal. That leaves us \$3262 short of being able to pay off the mortgage.

Including the generous matching amount, we have Souper Bowl funds of \$2309 to be split between Helping Harvest and ELCA World Hunger.

We also were able to give \$700 to the Hmong family whose mother passed away leaving her husband and small children.

Financially, March will be a very challenging month because of high expenses. There will be three paydays, a sizable propane bill, and insurance premiums which come due in March.


