


OTHER NEWS

BOOK SPOTLIGHT: *BEAUTIFUL DEMONS* (Book One of the *Shadow Demons* Saga) by Sarra Cannon

Not too long ago, I recently downloaded the ebook version to the *Shadow Demons Saga* (Sara Cannon created a box set with the first three books to the series) and just finished the first book in the series, *Beautiful Demons*. This was also the start of finding and promoting self-published authors in the indie community. So far, I really have gotten into the story even though it got off to a slow start in the beginning. Although you really don't know much about the main character of the book (Harper Madison) of the book and what powers she has until the very end of the first book (although she does hint that her powers are indeed one of a fiery nature), I highly recommend this book for readers who still love to read young adult novels in this day and age. If you are not into teen sex, I would recommend reading the book as well (I didn't encounter any sex scenes so far in Book one). Finally, if you are looking for a great Halloween read, this book is definitely for you.
