SB 0068 **Health Facilities** by Martin

Health Facilities; Revising the definition of the term “health facility” to include other entities and associations organized not for profit; revising the powers of health facilities authorities to include the power to issue certain loans and execute related loan agreements; specifying requirements for projects financed by loan agreements issued by a health facilities authority; authorizing, rather than requiring, a hospital to perform a confirmation test under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2025

SB 0106 **Exploitation of Vulnerable Adults** by Martin

Exploitation of Vulnerable Adults; Authorizing the use of substitute service on unascertainable respondents; requiring the court to enter an order providing for specified service when a petitioner files the sworn affidavit; requiring that any proposed transfer of funds or property in dispute be held for a specified time period, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2025

SB 0108 **Administrative Procedures** by Grall

Administrative Procedures; Requiring agencies to publish a certain notice of intended agency action within a specified timeframe; deleting a provision related to the timeframe within which rules are required to be drafted and formally proposed; providing that a proposal for a lower cost regulatory alternative submitted after a notice of change is made in good faith only if the proposal contains certain statements; requiring agencies, by a specified date and in coordination with the committee, to review specified rules adopted before a specified date; requiring that regulatory plans submitted by agencies include certain schedules for rule review and certain desired updates to such plans, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2025

SB 0112 **Children with Developmental Disabilities** by Harrell

Children with Developmental Disabilities; Revising the scope of the Dr. and Mrs. Alfonse and Kathleen Cinotti Health Care Screening and Services Grant Program to allow grant funds to be used for screenings, referrals for treatment, and related services for autism; revising requirements for the annual grant application submitted by the Department of Health for the Early Steps Program to conform to changes made by the act; providing a purpose for the Early Steps Extended Option; authorizing the department to implement the Early Steps Extended Option regardless of certain federal funding; requiring the University of Florida Center for Autism and Neurodevelopment to fund specialized summer programs for children with autism spectrum disorder, etc. APPROPRIATION: \$755,904 Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

SB 0158 **Coverage for Diagnostic and Supplemental Breast Examinations** by Berman

Coverage for Diagnostic and Supplemental Breast Examinations; Prohibiting the state group insurance program from imposing any cost-sharing requirement upon an enrollee with respect to coverage for diagnostic breast examinations or supplemental breast examinations, etc. Effective Date: 1/1/2026

SB 0168 Mental Health by Bradley

Mental Health; Citing this act as the “Tristin Murphy Act”; expanding the programs and diversion initiatives supported by implementation or expansion grants to include training for 911 public safety telecommunicators and emergency medical technicians for certain purposes and to include veterans treatment court programs; encouraging communities to apply for specified grants to establish misdemeanor or ordinance violation mental health diversion programs; encouraging communities to apply for specified grants to establish pretrial felony mental health diversion programs; expanding eligibility for the Forensic Hospital Diversion Pilot Program to include Hillsborough County, etc. APPROPRIATION: \$794,880 Effective Date: 10/1/2025

SB 0180 Emergencies by DiCeglie

Emergencies; Prohibiting certain local governments from adopting ordinances for substantial improvements or repairs to a structure which include cumulative substantial improvement periods; prohibiting certain entities from assessing impact fees for specified replacement structures; revising public hurricane shelter funding prioritization requirements for the Division of Emergency Management; authorizing certain servicemembers to provide medical care in specified circumstances; revising requirements for the state comprehensive emergency management plan, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise provided in this act, this act shall take effect upon becoming a law

SB 0312 Florida Institute for Human and Machine Cognition, Inc. by Gaetz

Florida Institute for Human and Machine Cognition, Inc.; Requiring the board of directors of the Florida Institute for Human and Machine Cognition, Inc., rather than the Board of Governors, to authorize the creation of a subsidiary of the corporation; revising the composition of the board of directors of the corporation; authorizing subsidiaries of the corporation to enter into certain affiliation agreements, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2025

SB 0344 Telecommunications Access System Act of 1991 by Rodriguez

Telecommunications Access System Act of 1991; Revising the powers and duties of the Florida Public Service Commission in overseeing the administration of the telecommunications access system; revising the duties of the system’s administrator; revising the procedures required for the distribution of specialized telecommunications devices; revising the composition of the advisory committee appointed to assist the commission with implementing the act, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2025

SB 0480 Nonprofit Agricultural Organization Medical Benefit Plans by DiCeglie

Nonprofit Agricultural Organization Medical Benefit Plans; Defining the term “nonprofit agricultural organization”; authorizing nonprofit agricultural organizations to provide medical benefit plans; specifying that such plans are not insurance for purposes of the Florida Insurance Code; prohibiting the nonprofit agricultural organization from marketing or selling a medical benefit plan through specified agents, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2025

HB 0519 Administration of Controlled Substances by Paramedics by Bartleman

Administration of Controlled Substances by Paramedics: Authorizes practitioner to cause certified paramedic to administer controlled substance. Effective Date: upon becoming a law

HB 0547 Medical Debt by Partington

Medical Debt: Revises definition; provides exception to prohibition of facility engaging in extraordinary collection action to obtain payment for services for sale of certain debt. Effective Date: July 1, 2025

HB 0597 Diabetes Management in Schools by Smith

Diabetes Management in Schools: Authorizes school district or public school to acquire & maintain supply of undesignated glucagon; requires that undesignated glucagon be stored in secure location that is immediately accessible; authorizes school district or public school to enter into arrangements with manufacturer or supplier to obtain glucagon free of charge or at fair market or reduced price; authorizes school district or public school to accept donated or transferred glucagon that meets certain requirements; authorizes school district or public school to obtain monetary donations or apply for grants to purchase glucagon; authorizes school district or public school to request prescription for glucagon from county health department; authorizes licensed health care practitioner to prescribe glucagon in name of school district or public school; authorizes licensed pharmacist to dispense glucagon pursuant to such prescription; requires participating school to make available undesignated glucagon to be administered as ordered in student's diabetes medical management plan or health care practitioner's orders; requires employee to call for emergency assistance & provide parental notification after administration of glucagon; requires State Board of Education to adopt rules; provides certain persons & entities with immunity from civil & criminal liability. Effective Date: July 1, 2025

SB 0612 Unlawful Distribution of Controlled Substances Resulting in Death by Burgess

Unlawful Distribution of Controlled Substances Resulting in Death; Defining the terms "dangerous fentanyl or fentanyl analogs" and "distribute"; creating an offense of murder in the third degree, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2025

HB 0633 Behavioral Health Managing Entities by Koster

Behavioral Health Managing Entities: Requires DCF to contract biennially for specified functions; requires department to contract for recommendations for certain transparency improvements; requires department to prepare & present to Governor & Legislature specified final report by specified date; requires managing entities to report required data to department in standardized electronic format; provides requirements for such format; requires managing entities to electronically submit to department certain documents in specified format & with specified metadata; requires managing entities to submit certain specific measures to department; requires department to post & maintain such measures on its website by specified date every month; provides exception; provides requirements for such measures; requires managing entities to report each measure using standard methodology determined by department; provides requirements for such measures; provides that implementation of specified requirements is contingent on certain appropriations. Effective Date: July 1, 2025

HB 0647	Advanced Practice Registered Nurse Services by Trabulsy Advanced Practice Registered Nurse Services: Revises who may file certificate of death or fetal death; revises definition of "primary or attending practitioner"; revises who may note corrected information on permanent certificate of death or fetal death. HB 0677	State Group Insurance Program Coverage of Standard Fertility Preservation Services by Trabulsy State Group Insurance Program Coverage of Standard Fertility Preservation Services : Requires DMS under state group health insurance plan policies to provide coverage of medically necessary expenses relating to standard fertility preservation services; prohibits state group health insurance plans from requiring preauthorization for such services; authorizes maximum benefit provisions & cost-sharing requirements. HB 0791	Surrendered Infants by Cobb Surrendered Infants : Revises definition of "infant"; defines "infant safety device"; authorizes certain hospitals, EMS stations, & fire stations to use infant safety devices to accept surrendered infants if device meets specified criteria; requires such hospitals, EMS stations, & fire stations to monitor inside of device 24 hours per day & physically check & test devices at specified intervals; provides additional requirements for certain fire stations using such devices. HB 0847	Expedited DNA Testing Grant Program by Johnson Expedited DNA Testing Grant Program: Creates Expedited DNA Testing Grant Program within FDLE; provides for annual award of grants; specifies uses of grants; requires annual report by each grant recipient; & provides rulemaking authority. HB 0907	Florida Institute for Pediatric Rare Diseases by Anderson Florida Institute for Pediatric Rare Diseases: Establishes Florida Institute for Pediatric Rare Diseases within FSU College of Medicine; & provides goals of institute; establishes Sunshine Genetics Pilot Program & Sunshine Genetics Consortium. SB 0944	Insurance Overpayment Claims Submitted to Psychologists by Davis Insurance Overpayment Claims Submitted to Psychologists; Requiring that insurance overpayment claims submitted to psychologists be submitted within a specified timeframe, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2025 Actions 05/20/2025 Approved by Governor; Chapter No. 2025-45
SB 0958	Type 1 Diabetes Early Detection Program by Bernard Type 1 Diabetes Early Detection Program; Requiring the Department of Health, in collaboration with school districts throughout this state, to develop informational materials for the early detection of Type 1 diabetes for parents and guardians of certain students; requiring early learning coalitions to notify parents and guardians of the availability of such informational materials, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2025

HB 0969 Reporting of Student Mental Health Outcomes by Cassel

Reporting of Student Mental Health Outcomes : Requires OPPAGA to submit initial specified evaluation to Governor & Legislature by specified date; requires office to submit final specified evaluation to Governor & Legislature by specified date; provides evaluation requirements. Effective Date: upon becoming a law

HB 1089 Newborn Screenings by Booth

Newborn Screenings: Beginning on specified date, subject to appropriation, provides that DOH's rules must require certain newborns to be screened for Duchenne muscular dystrophy. Effective Date: July 1, 2025

HB 1091 Substance Abuse and Mental Health Care by Gonzalez Pittman

Substance Abuse and Mental Health Care : Expands mental health crisis services to include the 988 suicide and crisis lifeline call center; authorizing a guardian advocate to be discharged when a patient is discharged from involuntary outpatient services; requiring clinical psychologists who make determinations of involuntary placement at certain mental health facilities to have specified clinical experience; authorizing a designated facility to retain a patient for the remainder of a specified timeframe under certain circumstances. Effective Date: July 1, 2025

SB 1156 Home Health Aide for Medically Fragile Children Program by Harrell

Home Health Aide for Medically Fragile Children Program; Providing requirements for the annual assessment of the home health aide for medically fragile children program; revising the utilization cap of a Medicaid fee schedule; requiring a home health aide for medically fragile children who works more than 40 hours per week to provide specified justification; requiring the agency to seek federal approval and implement federal waivers and state plan amendments for specified purposes, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

SB 1286 Harming or Neglecting Children by Grall

Harming or Neglecting Children; Revising the definition of the term "harm" as it relates to a child's health or welfare; revising the definition of the term "neglect of a child", etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2025

HB 1299 Department of Health by Yarkosky

Department of Health : Revising the repeal date of the definition of the term "messenger ribonucleic acid vaccine"; providing for contingent retroactive operation; requiring medical marijuana treatment centers to notify the Department of Health through e-mail within a specified timeframe after an actual or attempted theft, diversion, or loss of marijuana; revising eligibility criteria for licensure by endorsement under the MOBILE Act, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2025

HB 1487 Emergency Services by Basabe

Emergency Services: Removes limitation on number of red or red & white warning signals that certain vehicles may display; revises circumstances under which certain applicants for specified license are exempt from specified requirement; requires applicant seeking such exemption to submit sworn affidavit to DOH attesting to certain facts; revises number of counties that may be granted such exemption; prohibits licensed volunteer ambulance service from applying for, receiving funds under, or participating in certain grant programs. Effective Date: July 1, 2025

SB 1490 Children's Medical Services Program by Harrell

Children's Medical Services Program; Transferring operation of the Children's Medical Services Managed Care Plan from the Department of Health to the Agency for Health Care Administration, effective on a specified date; requiring the CMS program to conduct clinical eligibility screening for certain children and youth with special health care needs; revising the purposes and functions of the CMS program, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect upon becoming a law

HB 1545 Parkinson's Disease by Busatta

Parkinson's Disease: Establishes the Consortium for Parkinson's Disease Research within the University of South Florida; establishing the Parkinson's Disease Research Board; requiring the board to direct the operations of the consortium and to annually adopt a plan for Parkinson's disease research; providing duties of the consortium director; providing research requirements for the plan. Effective Date: July 1, 2025

HB 1567 Insulin Administration by Direct Support Professionals and Relatives by Tuck

Insulin Administration by Direct Support Professionals and Relatives: Defines "direct-support professional"; authorizes direct-support professionals & relatives of clients in group home facilities for individuals with developmental disabilities to administer insulin as prescribed to client if specified conditions are met; provides group home facilities, direct-support professionals, & relatives of clients with immunity from civil liability for damages & civil & criminal penalties; authorizes unlicensed direct service provider to supervise self-administration of insulin & epinephrine through use of specified devices. Effective Date: July 1, 2025

SB 1620 Mental Health and Substance Use Disorders by Rouson

Mental Health and Substance Use Disorders; Requiring the Department of Children and Families to require certain providers to use a specified assessment tool; requiring facilities to update treatment plans within specified timeframes; requiring use of a specified assessment tool; providing an exception; requiring the Criminal Justice, Mental Health, and Substance Abuse Technical Assistance Center at the Louis de la Parte Florida Mental Health Institute at the University of South Florida to disseminate among grantees certain evidence-based practices and best practices, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2025
