

Board of Education and Coordinating Council Recommendations to the Members of St. John's Congregation

Motion

That St John's Lutheran School, 1st grade - 8th grade, be closed at the end of the current school year (June 2025); therefore, the St. John's Preschool and Kindergarten (PS-K) will continue to operate for the 2025 -2026 school year, contingent upon the "Keep our School" task force meeting the conditions recommended by the St. John's Board of Education-School and the Coordinating Council.

Governing Conditions:

1. Reporting to the Board of Education-School, a task force appointed by the Coordinating Council is responsible for the marketing, promotion, staffing and enrollment of the PS-K program.
2. That the task force accepts the goal of 20 students for PS and 10 students for Kindergarten and report monthly on actual enrollment and the probability of reaching the minimum enrollment goals.
3. If enrollment goals are not achieved, the Board of Education-School, with the concurrence of the Coordinating Council, has discretion in deciding to close the program.
4. The members of St. John's congregation commit to supporting promotional efforts to keep the PS-K program operational for the 2025 -2026 school year and to fervent prayer and to financially support the church and school.

If these conditions are not met by July 15, 2025, the Preschool and Kindergarten may not reopen for the 2025 -2026 school year, at the discretion of the Board of Education-School with the concurrence of the Coordinating Council.
