 - a. What one thing sticks out to you from this passage? Why?
 - b. What is “darkness” in this passage?
 - c. What is “light” in this passage?
 - d. How does this passage point to the work of Jesus?
4. “Light” and “darkness” are found throughout the Bible. Look at the following passages. What is the “darkness”? How do these passages compare to verse 5: “The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.”?
 - a. Genesis 1:1-5
 - b. Isaiah 60:1-5
 - c. Luke 22:47-53
 - d. Ephesians 6:10-13
5. John 8:12 says: “Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, ‘I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.’” In what ways does Jesus show us He is the “light” spoken of in John 1:1-5, 9-13? How does this apply to you in your life of faith?
