□ <u>WORSHIP</u>: I resolve in the next 90 days to faithfully worship with the St. John's family at The 505 Contemporary Worship, Traditional Worship, or Livestream Worship.

Hebrews 10:25: Not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another...

Acts 2:42: And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.

□ <u>PRAY</u>: I resolve in the next 90 days to pray with and/or for someone.

1 Timothy 2:1: First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people...

☐ GROW: I resolve in the next 90 days to start/join a Small Group or Bible Study.

Acts 17:11: Now these Jews were more noble than those in Thessalonica; they received the word with all eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily to see if these things were so.
□ <u>FAMILY</u> : I resolve in the next 90 days to connect with my family in a special way.
Deuteronomy 6:6-7: And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.
$\Box$ <u>GIVE</u> : I resolve in the next 90 days to give a special financial contribution to St. John's and/or to a Christian charity that I'm passionate about.

$\hfill \square$ SERVE: I resolve in the next 90 days to serve people in need, in the Church and/or the community.
Galatians 6:10: So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith.
□ <u>SHARE</u> : I resolve in the next 90 days to share my faith in Jesus in some way (through conversation, social media, writing, art work, etc.)
Romans 10:13-15, 17: For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!" So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.
□ <u>CONNECT</u> : I resolve in the next 90 days to connect with someone that does not go to church or is far from God.
