(Luke 1:26-38)

1. What are your thoughts about the British royal family? Positive? Negative? Why?
2. Read Luke 1:26-38 and answer the following questions:
 - a. What is something that jumps out to you from this passage? Why?
 - b. What points of significance do you see in verses 26-27?
 - c. Compare the parallels between verses 32 and 35 and Luke 1:13-15. How is this important in reading our text?
 - d. How many “miracles” do you see in this text?
3. Gabriel, an “angelos” (Greek for “messenger”) was “sent from God”. Thus, his words were not his own; they were God’s. Furthermore, the words he spoke to Mary were specific in their context. Read the following passages. How do they add additional insight into the “annunciation” of Gabriel to Mary?
 - a. Genesis 49:10-12
 - b. Isaiah 9:6-7
 - c. 2 Samuel 7:16
4. Verse 37 reads: “For nothing will be impossible with God.” What is God saying to you personally through these words? What would be an appropriate response?
