The Injury Research Engagement Project (I-REP) Patient & Caregiver Panel is comprised of trauma survivors and their families who share their experiences with investigators to strengthen research proposals, better define desired outcomes, and improve communication between patient populations and research teams.

As partners in the research process, patients provide an important perspective that improves trauma investigations overall and leads to aligned expectations and better outcomes for injury survivors.

Meet Quarterly

Four Zoom meetings each year are held in the early evenings to accommodate work and family obligations.

Share Your Expertise

Panelists give feedback on investigators' proposals. They also have the option to join study teams and participate in publications.

Receive Compensation

Panelists receive a \$100 stipend for each session, attending as many as they have time for.
