Supplies food to children at the Boys and Girls Clubs, Neighborhood House, & several public schools.

This is a great opportunity to serve, and the time passes very quickly. Typically, we serve 350-400 people. We need about 12 volunteers for the serving lines; the work requires standing for about two hours. Jobs include distributing or collecting "tickets," carrying trays to those with difficulties, serving, putting food on trays, wiping down tables, and some general cleanup. (There are professionals for the heavy lifting.) At the St. Vincent de Paul Dining Hall (437 West 200 South, SLC). The parking lot is on the east side, but enter the parking lot on 2nd Street coming from the west.

About the Utah Pride Festival

From its humble beginnings in 1974 as an informal gathering in the park, the Utah Pride Festival is now a Salt Lake City event that grows bolder and brighter with every year. The Festival empowers the LGBTQ community of Salt Lake, as well as the state of Utah as a whole, to come together, celebrate and educate. The Festival is now attended by more than 35,000 people – including members of the LGBTQ community and their allies who want to show support – and continues to grow each year.

The 2019 theme is “Exist. Resist. Persist. Celebrating 50 years of Stonewall.”

Annual Pride Week events kick off the leading Thursday of Pride weekend with the Interfaith Service, which was held this year on Thu 5/30 at Christ UMC. Thank you to all of the dozens of faith communities and organizations who attended and supported and took part of this wonderful service!

Sun 6/2, 10:00am-12:00pm: Pride Parade
