ADVOCACY

Thu 1/31, 10:00am at the Utah Capitol: Faith & Poverty Day on the Hill

Crossroads Urban Center's Coalition of Religious Communities (CORC) has put together a three-part plan for reducing child homelessness. On 1/31, people from various faith traditions will gather at 10am in the auditorium of the State Office Building (behind the Utah Capitol) to draw attention to this plan & other key poverty issues. All are welcome.

This is a way for us to provide witness to decisions that attend to the welfare of all people, esp. those with limited incomes. This session of the Utah Legislature may put limits on the Medicaid expansion that voters approved in November, & may increase the sales tax on food (critically affecting those in poverty).
