Help Prevent the Spread with a #SafeDineOC \$1,000 Grant

The Orange County Board of Supervisors launched the **SafeDineOC COVID-Safe Restaurant Program** to provide funding to support local restaurants that are safely reopening amid the current pandemic.

Orange County restaurants are eligible for up to \$1,000 in reimbursements for CARES Act-qualified purchases, such as face masks, gloves, and other personal protective equipment (PPE), site reconfiguration, employee training, cleaning supplies, and more. Restaurant owners who own multiple sites must submit a separate application for each one.

The online SafeDineOC application is easy to complete:

1. Gather the Necessary Items

-  Current Health Permit Issued by County of Orange
-  Comply with California Restaurant Guidance
-  Completed Restaurant Checklist
-  Photo of Publicly Posted Completed Restaurant Checklist

-  Completed Attestation
-  Photo of Publicly Posted Completed Attestation
-  W9 Form
-  Purchase Receipts for CARES Act Qualified items

2. Fill out the Online Application at SafeDineOC.com and submit

Receipts for CARES Act-qualified purchases must be dated between March 1, 2020 and September 30, 2020, and are required for grant payment. Approved restaurants participating in the SafeDineOC program must post their attestation in plain sight for their customers to see. In addition to receiving \$1,000, grant recipients will be listed in a SafeDineOC COVID-Safe Restaurant directory on the program website.

The grant program will remain open until **October 6, 2020** or whenever funding is fully allocated, whichever occurs first. So, complete your application today!
