*Donation comes as more students are in need of computers and internet for distance learning amid COVID-19 pandemic*

**ORANGE COUNTY, Calif.** – July 28, 2020 – Cox Communications has donated 300 computers to Capistrano Unified School District (CUSD) to enable low-income families to connect with educators and resources during the current emergency distance learning state.
