To keep you informed, the City of Gulfport offers a number of ways to stay connected at the touch of a screen or click of a mouse.





City Council, Boards and Committee Meetings

The City of Gulfport has a Council-Manager form of government. A five person City Council is elected citywide by the voters, each for a two-year term, except for the Mayor who is elected to a three-year term. The City is divided into four wards, each of which is represented by one of the council members. The Mayor is the fifth member of the Council and is elected citywide, not representing any ward. The Mayor presides over the City Council Meetings, which are held the first and third Tuesdays of each month.

The City Council sets City policies, including adopting the budget on or before the beginning of each fiscal year, establishing local laws, and approving large expenditures of City funds. The five members of the City Council appoint a City Manager to run the day-to-day operations of the City. The City Manager is responsible for City finances and personnel management, as well as other administrative duties.

Planning and Zoning Board Meeting:

First Wednesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall.

Senior Citizens Advisory Committee Meeting:

Each month at 8:00 a.m. at the Senior Center.

Board of Adjustment Meeting:

Second Wednesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall.

All meetings are open to the public and are held in the City Hall, City Council Chambers, 2401 53rd Street South, In Person, unless otherwise noted. Meetings may occasionally be added, cancelled or rescheduled. Please check the city's website <https://mygulfport.us> for updated information.

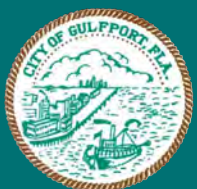

- **DEPOSIT:** A deposit is required of all residential properties serviced by the City of Gulfport, and must be received at time of making application for service to be turned on or transferred to a new tenant's name. Owners of multiple unit dwellings will be required to pay a deposit on each unit. In the event that a property owner's utility bill becomes two months past due and the service is disconnected, the City will require any past due amount to be paid in full before service is reinstated. The deposit will be refunded after the account is closed and the final bill has been deducted. Commercial property may require a larger deposit according to our City Ordinance.
- **TURN ON/OFF CHARGE:** There is a charge of for turning water service on or off between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday thru Friday plus an additional charge to read and transfer an account to another name. This charge will appear on your first billing statement. There will be an additional charge for turning the water on or off after normal working hours.
- **PAYMENTS:** You may pay your city utility bill by cash, check or credit card at the Customer Service Department in City Hall or Online at www.municipalonlinepayments.com/gulfportfl. If you elect to sign up for direct debit for automatic bill payment, please complete the attached "Direct Debit" form with a voided check, and return to the Customer Service Department in City Hall.
- **BILLING:** Your meter is read monthly and a bill is mailed the Thursday of the week following the reading of your meter. Bills are due and payable when rendered. If payment is not received in our office within 21 days after the billing date, it will be considered late and assessed a delinquent charge per month on the unpaid balance. After four weeks, your service will be turned off for nonpayment. All monies due on the account plus a reconnect fee must be paid in order to have service restored. Tampering with any meter is strictly prohibited and punishable by law.

- **RETURNED CHECKS:** There will be a charge for service and handling each time a check is returned to us by the bank. If your service has been disconnected for a non-accepted check, the entire amount due plus all fees must be paid before the service is restored. In the event that two non accepted checks are presented within a 12-month period, you will be required to pay by cash for six months. Another returned check and the account will be permanently cash only.
- **STANDBY:** If you are the owner and going away for 3 months or longer, you may find it saves to discontinue service and place your account on a stand-by status. The Customer Service personnel will be happy to explain this option to you.

Public Works / Utility Customer Service

• GARBAGE COLLECTION

- ✓ Garbage collection is provided twice a week, either Monday and Thursday or Tuesday and Friday based on your residential address.
- ✓ Residents in the standard, rear-loading collection areas are limited to a maximum of 3 metal or plastic trash containers, plastic bags or combination thereof, not exceeding 32 gallons or 50 lbs each.
- ✓ Residents in the automated collection areas are limited to the city provided trash container. The city provided trash container cannot exceed 50 lbs.
- ✓ Containers must be in good condition, watertight and have 2 handles. Plastic bags must be secured with a twist tie or clip.
- ✓ Containers or bags must be placed at the curb or alley no earlier than 5:00 p.m. on the day proceeding and no later than 7:00 a.m. on the day of your designated collection day.
- ✓ Containers must be removed from the curb or alley the day of collection.

• CURBSIDE / DROP-OFF RECYCLING

- ✓ Call Public Works at 727-893-1089 to request a free set of curbside recycle bins.
- ✓ Curbside recycling is provided once per week based on your residential address.
- ✓ Items must be placed in the city issued recycling containers.
- ✓ The following items are accepted for curbside recycling:
 - Steel Cans
 - Aluminum cans
 - Plastic bottles and/or containers
 - Mixed Paper
 - Cardboard
 - Newspaper
- ✓ The City of Gulfport provides drop-off dumpsters at the Gulfport Neighborhood Center, located at 1617 – 49th Street South for:
 - ✓ Glass
 - Brown, Green and Clear food and/or beverage containers
 - Emptied and rinsed
 - Labels are acceptable
 - ✓ Cardboard
 - 3-layer corrugated boxes or packaging
 - Cleaned, emptied, dry and flattened
 - Pizza box TOPS only
 - ✓ Mixed Paper
 - Paper or paper product that tears (White or colored paper, magazines or catalogs, phone books, wrapping paper, cereal boxes, paper towel rolls, etc.)
- ✓ Plastic bags can be deposited in the collection buckets throughout the City of Gulfport parks.
- ✓ Collection boxes for rechargeable batteries and cell phones are located at Gulfport Neighborhood Center (1617 – 49th Street South) and the Senior Center (5501 – 27th Avenue South).

• YARD WASTE PICKUP

- ✓ Yard waste piles, bagged leaves and Special Pick-ups must be placed at the curb or alley for pick up.
- ✓ A single pile, (per resident), of tree and shrubbery trimmings, will be picked up every Wednesday at no charge. Trimmings must not be bagged or bundled, but gathered neatly in a pile not to exceed 3.5 feet high, 4 feet wide or 4 feet long. Trimmings cannot exceed 4 inches in diameter.
- ✓ Mower clippings and leaves must be bagged. You must call Public Works at 727-893-1089 to schedule a free pick up of these bags.
- ✓ Any amount of debris exceeding the above limitations will be considered a Special Pick-up. Special Pick-ups must be scheduled with Public Works and will be billed as an extra charge on your utility bill.

Public Works / Utility Customer Service

- ✓ All hired lawn service, tree trimming service or other such contractors are required by City Ordinance to remove and dispose of the yard waste. If your contractor offers you a discount for leaving the yard waste and having the City pick it up, please be aware that this must be called in as a "special pickup" and will be billed as an extra charge on your utility bill. The contractor may also receive a fine.

▪ SPECIAL PICK-UPS

- ✓ Call Public Works at 727-893-1089 to schedule the removal of any Special Pick-up.
- ✓ Special Pick-up item(s) or pile(s) must be placed at the curb or alley for pick-up.
- ✓ Special Pick-up fees can be found at, <https://mygulfport.us/public-works-department/residential-sanitation-service/>.

Excessive amounts of Trash, Debris, Yard Waste and/or Brush

- ✓ No trash is allowed to accumulate for a period of longer than 72 hours. Any accumulation of trash that cannot be placed in the allotted trash containers twice a week will be considered a Special Pick-up and shall be picked up by the city, with or without notification by the resident. An additional fee will be charged according to the size of the load and billed as an additional charge on the utility bill.

▪ **HOUSEHOLD / BUSINESS ELECTRONICS & CHEMICALS MOBILE COLLECTION:** Household chemicals such as fertilizers, pesticides, paint, paint thinners and similar materials and electronics are accepted free of charge once per year at the city's household chemical cleanup event at the 49th Street Neighborhood Center. Household chemicals may also be taken to the Pinellas County Household Chemical Collection Center located at 2855 109th Avenue North. Call 727-464-7500 for more details.

▪ **ITEMS THAT ARE PROHIBITED BY LAW:** It is illegal to place any of the following items in your curbside trash containers:

- ✓ Biohazardous Waste – Please reference "Household Chemicals" above or "The A-Z Guide for Recycling & Disposal" found at <https://mygulfport.us/public-works-department/residential-sanitation-service>.
- ✓ Radiological waste – You can make arrangements for the disposal of radiological waste from obsolete smoke detectors by calling the Gulfport Fire Department at 727-893-1059. If you are aware of any other radiological waste, you may also call the Gulfport Fire Department for advice.
- ✓ Contagious Disease Solid Waste – Speak to your physician or pharmacist for a list of licensed medical waste collectors.
- ✓ Flammable, Explosive or Toxic Materials – Call the Gulfport Fire Department at 727-893-1059 for advice on how to dispose of these materials.

DIRECT DEBIT

With DIRECT DEBIT service from the City of Gulfport, your utility bill is automatically paid from your checking or savings account fourteen (14) calendar days after the billing date. You will still receive a regular monthly statement. Instead of writing a check, you simply deduct the amount from your bank account.

To sign up for DIRECT DEBIT service, complete this order form, include a voided check imprinted with your name and address and send it to Utility Customer Service at the above address.

Continue to pay your bill regularly until you receive your first bill that indicates you are on the DIRECT DEBIT program. If you need more information, contact Utility Customer Service at (727) 893-1016.

SEPARATE YOUR CURBSIDE RECYCLING INTO 2 GROUPS

PLASTIC, STEEL AND ALUMINUM

- Plastic bottles and/or containers
- Steel (tin) food cans such as soup or vegetable cans
- Aluminum cans

* **NO** lids, aerosol or paint cans and everything must be empty and rinsed

MIXED PAPER

- Mixed paper (junk mail, office paper, magazines, etc.)
- Cardboard (must fit inside bin)
- Newspaper and phone books

* **NO** string, twine, plastic bags, paper towels, tissues, paper plates/cups or shredded paper

The City provides **drop-off dumpsters** at the Gulfport Neighborhood Center, located at 1617, 49th St. S., for Glass (green, brown and clear), cardboard and mixed paper.

Special services and programs:

- ✓ **Vacation House checks** - Go to <http://www.gulfportpolice.com/house-check-request.html> and fill out the online form at least two weeks before your trip. Officers will conduct perimeter checks while you are away.
- ✓ **Security Survey** - We have experts who can survey your property and provide tips on simple, cost-effective improvements that can reduce your risk of being victimized. To schedule a survey, contact us at 893-1041.
- ✓ **Bike registrations** - Register your bike in the records department to help us retrieve it in case of it being lost or stolen. A small fee of \$0.25.
- ✓ **Operation Santa** - Thirty plus years and running, the volunteers at Operation Santa have been taking care of Gulfport children who need a little extra for their Holiday. This event usually takes place after Thanksgiving through December 15. Whether giving or receiving, the phone number during that time is 727-893-1097 and leave a message.
- ✓ **Neighborhood Watch Program** - Opportunities right in your neighborhood to volunteer and keep your neighbors informed. Call the coordinator at 727-893-1022 for more information.
- ✓ **Citizens Police Academy** - Typically once per year (more or less depending on demand), we host a citizens' academy which gives participants an in-depth look at how we do business. The program runs for eight-teen weeks, one night per week, and attendees will experience everything from the crash investigation and communications center to the gun range and the pursuit driving course. - ✓ **Explorer Post** - For youth between the ages of 14 and 21 who want to learn more about a potential career field. Law Enforcement is but one of many types of Exploring units. Members attend biweekly meetings, quarterly regional meetings, and annual state and/or national competitions. Experienced members can participate in ride-alongs with police officers and may also be selected to compete on the Explorer shooting team.

Fire Chief Rene Fernandez

Rene Fernandez is currently the Fire Chief for the City of Gulfport Fire Rescue along with being the EMS co-ordinator for the department. Fire Chief Fernandez began his career with Gulfport Fire Rescue in 2006 as a Firefighter/Paramedic, was promoted to Lieutenant Paramedic in October of 2017, and was then promoted to the position of Fire Captain Paramedic on October 21st of 2019. Fire Chief Fernandez officially assumed the role of Fire Chief on January 10th of 2023. Fire Chief Fernandez has also been a resident of the City of Gulfport since 2007.

Fire Chief Fernandez has worked in many different roles with the Department including Driver Operator, Lieutenant Paramedic, Captain Paramedic and has overseen the medical operations of the Department since the time of being promoted to Lieutenant Paramedic. Fire Chief Fernandez has extensive education in the medical field including a current certification as a Paramedic, Registered Nurse, ACLS, PHTLS, EPC, and CPR instructor with the American Heart Association. He has also obtained a Bachelor's Degree in Science and an Associate's Degree in Arts. Fire Chief Fernandez also has extensive training on the fire service side of things including certifications as a Pump Operator, Fire Instructor III, Fire Inspector, Fire Officer I, and Fire Officer II.

Gulfport Fire Rescue

Currently, Gulfport Fire Rescue has (2) 40 hour fulltime Fire Captains. One specializes in Fire Inspections/Fire Investigations and the other specializes in Advanced Life Support, Emergency Medical Services. Gulfport Fire Rescue has three shifts of five personnel operating an Advanced Life Support (ALS) Engine and Rescue. Gulfport Fire Rescue maintains five firefighters per shift that includes at least one Fire Lieutenant and one Paramedic. Each shift works 24 hours on and 48 hours off. The Fire Chief is responsible for the overall operation of the department. Each of the Fire Lieutenants is responsible for a specific area of supervision and coordination, Training, Safety, and EMS in addition to their shift supervision duties.

Gulfport Fire Rescue operates out of a single fire station and is responsible for the protection of 12,500 residents living within the City of 3 square miles. Additionally, the department participates in a County-wide Automatic Aid agreement with frequent fire responses into St. Petersburg and South Pasadena, and Mutual Aid responses into these areas and the beach communities of St Pete Beach and Treasure Island. Gulfport Fire Rescue responds to nearly 3000 emergency incidents annually.

The fire station houses the living quarters and the administrative area. Originally occupied in 1976, it was renovated and modernized during 2003 with the living quarters expanded and separated from the administrative area.

Gulfport Fire rescue provides Advanced Life Support Emergency Medical Services; Fire Suppression; Fire Inspections based on the NFPA Life Safety Code; Public Education for Fire Safety, Hurricane Preparedness, Pool Safety, CPR training; free Home Fire Safety Surveys; free Smoke Detectors and installation.

The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Program educates people about disaster preparedness for hazards that may impact their area and trains them in basic disaster response skills, such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, and disaster medical operations. CERT members are trained in CPR/AED and basic first aid. Using the training learned in the classroom and during exercises, CERT members can assist others in their neighborhood or workplace following an event when professional responders are not immediately available to help. CERT members also are encouraged to support emergency response agencies by taking a more active role in emergency preparedness projects in their community. Gulfport CERT meetings are held every third Monday of the month at 7 p.m. CERT meeting locations will vary due to the type of scheduled training for the month. Gulfport Municipal Marina

Gulfport Municipal Marina lies on approximately eleven (11) acres of land and approximately seven and one half (7.5) acres of water. Marina property is surrounded by mostly residential single family homes. The marina basin is enclosed with a concrete seawall and provides one hundred ninety two (192) wet slips open to the public. The marina includes twenty five (25) dry boat storage spaces, ship store with restrooms and showers, public boat ramp with seventy (70) boat trailer parking spaces, two fueling stations, lighted range markers and guest docking facility.



Clam Bayou is adjacent to the East side of the marina channel. The park offers several fishing docks as well as passive walking trails, dock walk, kayak launch and Osprey nests.

The Gulfport Marina Ship Store is open seven (7) days a week, three hundred sixty three (363) days a year. The ship store contains the office of the Harbormaster and marina staff. The ship store provides drinks, sandwiches, snacks, marine supplies, live and frozen bait and full compliments of tackle. There are two restroom facilities with showers. The ship store transmits free internet access to all marina patrons and guest docking facilities. The ship store has two fueling stations with gas and diesel at each fuel dispenser. The marina boasts one hundred forty (140) feet of floating fuel dock.

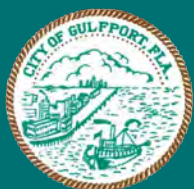

The Community Development Department is comprised of 3 Divisions:

- Building Division – primary duties include building permitting and inspections, and Business Tax Receipts.
- Planning Division – primary duties include comprehensive planning, zoning, and grant writing.
- Code Enforcement – primary duties include enforcement of city code of ordinances.

BUILDING DIVISION

PERMITTING – Permitting questions may be directed to staff either via the telephone or e-mail. Inquires can be directed to (727) 892-1024 or to permits@mygulfport.us. Our counter staff make sure that inquiries are sent to the correct person or persons to answer any questions. This includes questions about what materials may be needed for permit applications, questions about the process, or to schedule meetings to discuss your project. You may wish to come into the Community Development Department located in the Public Services building at 5330 23rd Avenue S. to discuss issues in person. While a resident homeowner can generally pull permits, it is suggested that a licensed contractor be used as they will be familiar with the necessary paperwork and production of construction plans. Permit applications are available on the city website at <https://mygulfport.us/permit-application>.

GARAGE SALE PERMITS – Code permits Gulfport residents to (6) six garage sale permits per year, one every 60 days. You can obtain a free permit at the Building Department, 5330 23rd Ave. S. or online at <https://mygulfport.us/garage-sale-permits>. Should you have any questions, please call 727-893-1061.

INSPECTIONS – There are inspections required for most permits. The number and type of inspections are dependent on the project. Inspections are necessary to ensure compliance with the Florida Building Code. Inspections must be scheduled on the inspection line at (727) 893-1057 before 3:00 p.m. for a next day inspection. If a contractor is used, they are generally responsible for the scheduling of inspections.

BUSINESS TAX RECEIPTS – All businesses located in the city need a business tax receipt. An application can be found on-line under the Community Development tab. You can also request one at permits@mygulfport.us or by phone at (727) 893-1063. The application is also used to determine zoning compliance to make sure the proposed business is allowed in the desired location. You will also be asked about any proposed construction that may be necessary for the business that may require a permit.

PLANNING DIVISION

The Planning Division is responsible for compliance with both the Comprehensive Plan and the Zoning Code. The zoning map and the Comprehensive plan, which includes the Future Land Use Map, can be found on the city website at <https://mygulfport.us/community-development>. The Zoning Code (Chapter 22 of the Gulfport Code of Ordinances) can be found at https://library.municode.com/fl/gulfport/codes/code_of_ordinances. Inquires can be directed to (727) 892-1024 or to permits@mygulfport.us. It is important that what you want to do meets all applicable Zoning Code requirements including the use, location, setbacks and all other applicable regulations.

CODE ENFORCEMENT DIVISION

COMPLIANTS - Questions may be directed to staff either via the telephone or e-mail. Inquires can be directed to (727) 892-1061 or to permits@mygulfport.us.

If you have a complaint, you may report it to (727) 892-1061 or to permits@mygulfport.us. We will inspect as soon as possible to verify any violation. If the inspector is unavailable, leave as detailed a message as possible to help us find the violation. As of July 1, 2021, Chapter 162 of the Florida Statutes (CS/HB 60) was amended to preclude staff from initiating code enforcement proceedings by way of anonymous complaints. A person who reports a potential violation of a code or an ordinance must provide, at a minimum, their name and address to the respective local government. Any personal information provided in any manner becomes part of the public record, which anyone has the right to review. If you do not provide the required information, then staff cannot start a case. There are exceptions such as an imminent threat to public safety, or welfare or imminent destruction of habitat or sensitive resources.

TREE REMOVAL – A Tree Removal Permit is available on the City Website under the Community Development tab. You can also request one at permits@mygulfport.us or by phone at (727) 893-1024. There is no charge for the permit. The permit allows staff to schedule an inspection to verify the tree meets the requirements for removal. The tree ordinance can be found in the Zoning Code (Chapter 22 of the Gulfport Code of Ordinances) at https://library.municode.com/fl/gulfport/codes/code_of_ordinances.

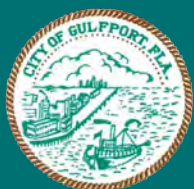
Section 163.045 of the Florida Statutes was recently amended to state “that a local government may not require a notice, application, approval, permit, fee, or mitigation for the pruning, trimming, or removal of a tree on residential property if the property owner obtains documentation from an arborist certified by the International Society of Arboriculture or a Florida licensed landscape architect that the tree presents a danger to persons or property”. If you or your contractor are using this section to remove a tree, be aware that a report prepared by a certified arborist must be obtained or code enforcement actions may occur. Ask the proposed tree service contractor if they will obtain a permit or prepare the required documentation before you sign any contracts. It may be easier to obtain the no-fee tree permit. Many local contractors, familiar with the laws, have worked with the city to make sure any removal is done properly and legally. Pruning and trimming do not require a permit as long as the tree is not damaged by the trimming.
