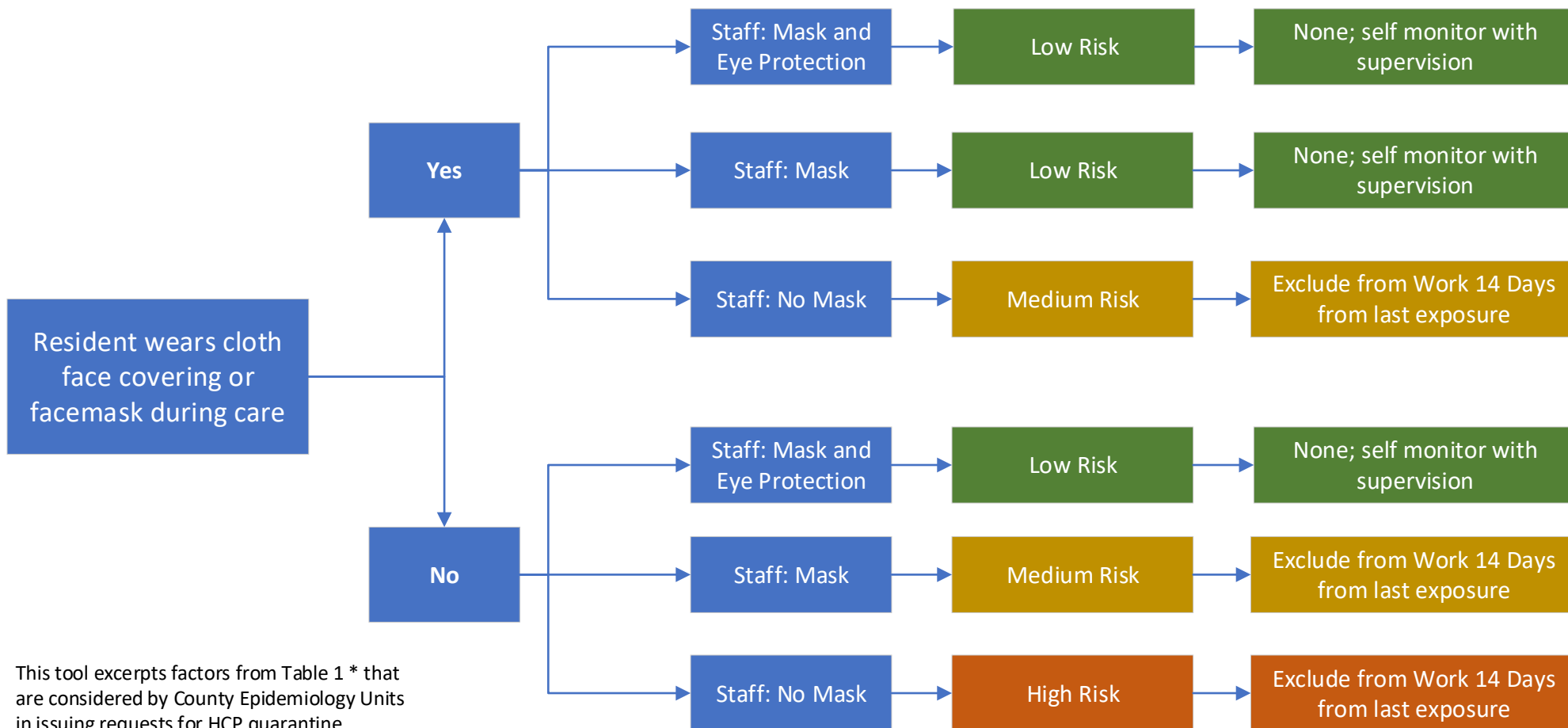


Source Control and Work Restriction Expectations* with COVID-19 Exposure
