We are writing to invite you to support the **Seventh Annual Walk for Women's Cancers and our first-ever certified 5K Run**, hosted in conjunction with Bergen County Technical Schools. The event will take place on Sunday, October 4, 2026, at Bergen Community College in Paramus, New Jersey, with a virtual participation option available nationwide.

The Lewin Fund to Fight Women's Cancers® (www.thelewinfund.org) is a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization (Tax ID 46-1628320) dedicated to addressing one of the most pressing health challenges facing women and their families today. One in three women will face cancer in her lifetime, and our mission is to ensure that no woman faces that journey without support.

Proceeds from the Walk directly fund groundbreaking women's cancer research and critical quality-of-life services that help bridge gaps in care—many of which have only grown in recent years. These services include transportation assistance, food pantry programs, house-cleaning support during treatment, and psychosocial and behavioral health services for patients and their families.

What distinguishes The Lewin Fund from many other organizations is our unwavering commitment to impact. Our Board of Directors is entirely voluntary, and no one at The Lewin Fund receives a salary. This ensures that every dollar raised goes directly to the programs and research we support. We treat every donation as an opportunity to meaningfully change a woman's life.

Quality of Life Improvement

Preventative Strategies

Educational initiatives including free community wellness symposia and targeted outreach programs—such as events designed to educate and support Latina women—focused on cancer prevention, early detection, and healthy living.

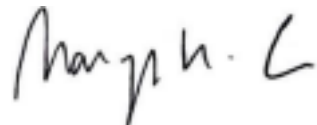
Innovative Research

Funding for pioneering research efforts, including studies on HER2-expressing solid tumors, next-generation sequencing of rare ovarian cancers, endometrial and ovarian cancer translational research trials at Dana-Farber Cancer Institute, and integrative treatment approaches such as acupuncture in partnership with the Judith Ehm Foundation.
