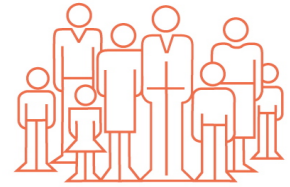

Praying The Examen

A Simply Sacred Everyday Practice

1. Become aware of God's presence in and around and through all things.
2. Review the day with gratitude. Use the *Thank you, Thank you, Thank you*, prayer if needed.
3. Pay attention to, and name the emotions from the day.
4. Choose one hard truth from the day and pray from it. Ask to see God's presence in the midst of it, then release it to the work of the Holy Spirit.
5. Look toward tomorrow with freedom and hope.
