This designation is reserved for programs that have effectively delivered a quality, evidence-based program that meets all of the standards for CDC recognition. The sustained success of Healthy Acadia's Diabetes Prevention and Lifestyle Change Program is making an invaluable contribution to the prevention of type 2 diabetes, both in our communities and as part of the National Diabetes Prevention Program (DPP).

CDC-recognized organizations achieving preliminary or full recognition status may enroll in Medicare as Medicare Diabetes Prevention Program (MDPP) suppliers. Enrollment in Medicare as an MDPP supplier is required before an organization be reimbursed through Medicare for in-person DPP services provided to eligible beneficiaries.
