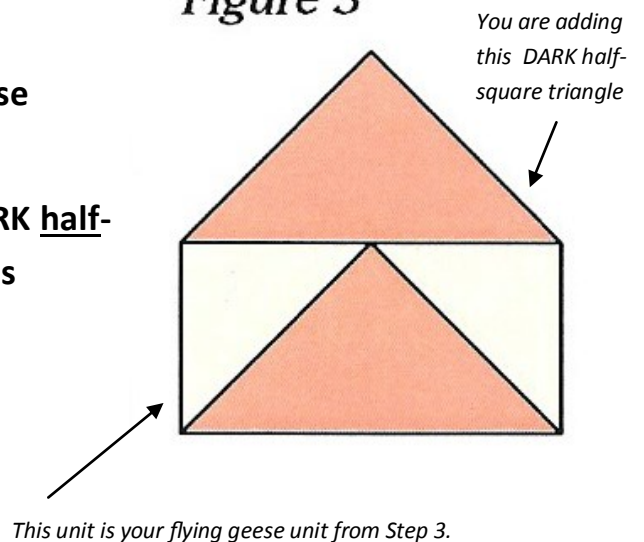
STEP 4 Mystery at the Mansion

Last wee the instructions had us make 64 flying geese units.

Now, we're going to enlarge those units! Sew a DARK half-square triangle to each flying geese unit. This makes "double flying geese" units.

Repeat to make 64 double flying geese units.

SOME BASIC QUILTING TERMINOLOGY that you'll hear often:

QUARTER INCH SEAM: unless otherwise stated in your pattern, all seams are sewn with an accurate quarter-inch seam

QUARTER square triangle: 4 triangles diagonally cut from a square



HALF Square triangle: 2 equal triangles diagonally cut from a square



WOF: Width of Fabric (selvage to selvage)
