HINTS & INFO: MYSTERY IN THE MANSION is a fun quilt that will measure 48" x 48" without borders or additional blocks; with borders as the pattern is written it will measure 62 x 62". (The Fabric Requirements shown below are for the sizes mentioned so if you add blocks or more borders, you'll need more fabric.) For MYSTERY IN THE MANSION, you'll want to choose fabrics with HIGH contrast. Feel free to make it scrappy by choosing several fabrics in each of two contrasting colors, or JUST go for it and use many colors as long as you stick with LIGHTS and DARKS! The Mansion's block will be 12" square. Setting for this quilt as the mystery is written is 4 blocks x 4 blocks. This pattern is rated as "easy" and assumes you have basic quilting skills like good quarter-inch seams, proper pressing, etc. However if you have any questions be sure to make contact with the shop!



Fabric Requirements:

BLOCKS: 1-1/8 Yard LIGHTS; 2 Yards DARKS

BORDERS: 1 Yard for inner border & binding; 1 yard for outer border.

STEP 1 (Cutting)

FROM YOUR LIGHTS: Cut seven 5-1/4" WOF (Width of Fabric) strips. Subcut into 48, 5-1/4" squares. Cut each square twice diagonally to make 192 triangles.

FROM YOUR DARKS: Cut three 5 1/4" WOF strips and subcut into sixteen 5 1/4" squares. Cut each square twice diagonally to make 64 triangles.

Cut eight 4 7/8" WOF strips and subcut into 64 4-7/8" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to make 128 triangles.

Cut two 4-1/2" WOF strips and subcut into sixteen 4-1/2" squares.
