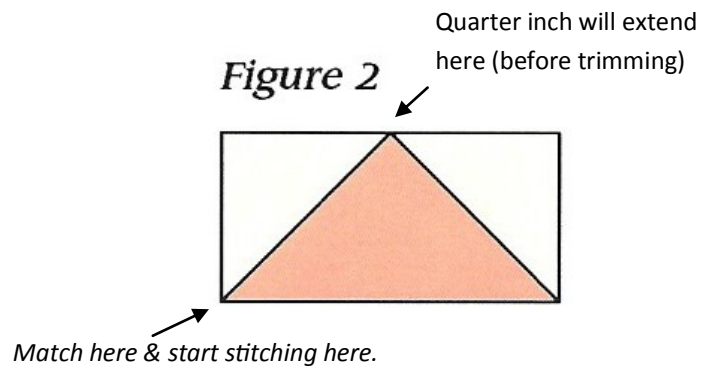
STEP 3 Mystery at the Mansion

With right sides together, add a LIGHT quarter-square triangle to one of the shorter sides of a DARK half-square triangle. Press open. Add another light quarter-square triangle to the other shorter side of the dark half-square triangle.

This forms a “flying geese” unit.

Make 64 flying geese. (I just love making flying geese...this is a historic unit...a true basic of piecing skills.)

Some folks might question where to start stitching (and thus which side will have a 1/4” extension.) Match up your triangles on the corner AWAY from the goose’s “nose” so that each wing will extend a quarter of an inch. Be careful because often our machines like to “eat” this small piece of fabric...making sure you have nice sharp needle, long thread tails when you begin stitching and chain piecing your units will solve that problem.
