


# Girls E-Mentorship

Girls E-Mentorship (GEM) is a top 100 rated charity offering a research-based mentorship program for high school girls facing socioeconomic barriers to build their professional skills and achieve their academic and career potential.

GEM connects self-identified high school girls with a professional mentor located for a 9-month period and provides a comprehensive online leadership and professional development curriculum.

1. Self-identified girls in grades 10-12 facing financial and/or other systemic barriers
2. Hard-working individuals actively engaged in their community
3. Individuals that are ambitious, inquisitive, passionate, and committed to self-development

## Our Program Pillars



Mentorship: We connect self-identified high school girls from the GTA with a female adult mentor for a 9-month mentorship relationship.



GEMinars: We host experiential career workshops designed to help mentees develop professional skills and increase their knowledge of career opportunities.



GEMenrichments: Our corporate partners host optional knowledge sharing workshops to enrich mentees personal and professional experiences.



Scholarships: With the help of our donors, we offer scholarships to mentees who display exceptional initiative to help assist them in their educational goals.




Internships: Our corporate partners offer paid summer internships offered to GEM girls geared towards skill-development and resume building.
