Canadian Language Benchmark Test May be Required

*If your transcripts are from a non-English speaking country, you'll need a Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) Test

- Test must be current with 6 months
- All benchmarks must be six or higher for credit courses except for ESL Credit (Level 3 or higher)
