In 2020 Christina was recognized for these efforts with the Fred J. Morton Government Lawyer of the Year Award from the El Paso Bar Association. She is past President of the El Paso Women's Bar Association and serves on the board of the Rural Schools Education Program & Scholarship Foundation. In May 2019 Christina was elected to serve as the El Paso Community College District 4 Trustee where she also serves as the Board Secretary.
