The Pacific Club was founded by business and professional leaders in Orange County as a private city club where members would be able to meet, socialize and transact business. The first Pacific Club facility opened in 1983 in the renovated Lakeside Restaurant in Newport Beach, CA. In 1986 the Club expanded the number of meeting rooms and added a state-of-the-art Health and Fitness Center. In 2006 the Clubhouse was raised, and a new Clubhouse opened with a newly designed exhibition kitchen, patio dining attached to the Talbot Grill, Member's Bar, a library, living room and 5 additional meeting rooms. The walls of the Pacific Club are adorned with artwork from The Pacific Art Foundation, the Joan Irvine Smith and John Swindon collections, and the Beaumont Collection.

Parking:

Complimentary Parking on site at The Pacific Club **with validated ticket**. Take exit for MacArthur Blvd from I-405 toward John Wayne Airport. Proceed on MacArthur Blvd to light at Von Karman and turn left on Von Karman. Take first left turn on Von Karman into parking lot and take ticket at the gate. <u>Bring your ticket into The Pacific Club for validation at the front desk.</u>
