Dear Folsom Veterans Day Parade Participants:

Thank you for your upcoming participation in our 24th Annual Wayne Spence Folsom Veterans Day Parade. We are honored that you can join us as we celebrate our local veterans. The parade is to honor our veterans and so we ask that you follow these very simple, but important rules:

- All entries and floats should be decorated in a patriotic theme (show your red, white, and blue spirit!)
- All entries and floats must focus on honoring veterans. Entries and floats self-promoting businesses and/or political advertisement will not be tolerated and may be excluded from the parade.
- The handing out of coupons or flyers to self-promote a business or political advertisement is not acceptable and will not be tolerated.
- Candy or any objects are not permitted to be thrown during the parade. Violators may be excluded from the parade.

Please help keep this tradition of honoring our military veterans enjoyable for everyone, and we hope to see you out at the parade!

Staging area info:

Entry Parking: Only those vehicles that are in the Parade line up will be allowed to enter the staging area.

Parade vehicles should use the north entrance to the Home Goods parking lot off Montrose Dr. There is a large parking lot in the Lowes shopping center across Montrose Dr. from the staging area for non-parade vehicles. If you are dropping off parade participants or marching in the parade, please park in an adjacent parking lot and walk to the staging area.

Arrive at Staging Area: Arrive at the staging area at assigned time and find your entry number. Your arrival time will be sent with your entry confirmation. Entry numbers will be identified with an orange cone. Volunteers will be available to assist you in the staging area.

Trailers, Tractors, Horses, and other Animals: If your entry involves a trailer, such as for horses or tractors, please off load your horses or tractor prior to entering the staging area. Additional parking can be found at the Lowe's shopping center. **For entries with animals, please be sure to assign a member of your group to follow behind and thoroughly clean any animal waste on the parade route and including areas in the staging area.**

Pack it in/Pack it out: Please throw away any trash and debris produced in the staging/parking lot area. Folsom Square Shopping Center (Home Goods) has been gracious enough to allow this great event to take place in their parking lot. **Please use provided garbage and recycle bins.**

Entry/Line-Up Identification: Please print the last page which identifies your entry and line-up number. If you are in a vehicle or on a float, please post and/or attach in an area clearly visible on the front left-side (driver's side) of the vehicle/float. If you are a marching group, please make all effort for your group to be identifiable to parade announcer (parade announcer will be on your left as you approach the reviewing stand towards the end of the parade).

Additional parade info:

Street Closures: Portions of Montrose St., East Bidwell St., Coloma St., and Natoma St. will be closed to all traffic from approximately 8:00am to 11:0am.

Participant Shuttle: There will be an RT Bus at the parade finish area to transport participants back to the Home Goods parking lot (parade start).

Rain: The Parade will go rain or shine. It will be up to each entry to decide if they want to participate. The Parade will not proceed if lightning is present.

Review Stand: There will be a reviewing stand near the end of the Parade route on Natoma Street in City Lions Park. The Parade announcer will read entry information from submitted entry forms only. Please make sure your entry is easily identifiable for the parade announcer. **If you will be performing in front of the reviewing stand, we ask that you limit your performance to no more than 1 minute.**

Veterans Flag Ceremony: A brief ceremony will be held at the Veterans Memorial located in City Lions Park near the parade finish and at the conclusion of the parade.
