

Sacramento Chapter Appointed Positions:

Genealogist: The Assistant Registrar and/or Genealogist will aid the Registrar in research and preparation of applications.

Chaplain: The Chaplain may be asked by the President to offer an Invocation or Benediction in connection with any regular or special meeting of the membership. He may be an ordained clergyman or may be a layman if he is a Chapter member. A visiting clergyman may be asked to function as Chaplain. The Chapter Chaplain may be assigned such other duties by the President as will improve the spiritual well-being of the Chapter members, such as visiting the sick, shut-ins, etc.

Sgt at Arms: The Sergeant at Arms shall be responsible for the safe keeping of the Chapter's collection of historic flags and other paraphernalia and have them available for use at Chapter meetings and/or events as needed.

Courier Editor: The Editor of the *Courier* shall be responsible for notifying the membership of meetings, items of major interest including payment of dues, and news items, through the publication of the Sacramento Chapter *Courier*.

Color Guard Commander: The Color guard Commander trains and schedules the Chapter Color Guard members attendance at various local patriotic events.

Web Master: The Web Master shall be responsible for maintaining the Chapter's web site. This includes, but is not limited to, resolving technical problems, updating the chapter information, and posting the current *Courier* to the web site
