NETWORK CHARGE

The Behavioral Health PLN is established under the advisement of School District and Agency Leaders to support camaraderie, collaboration, and shared learning among professionals who together seek to elevate the importance of mental wellness and reduce stigma around behavioral health for students and adults in school settings. Each meeting will include a community-building activity, a learning topic, a discussion on collaboration opportunities, and a time for updates and announcements from CSF, agencies, and schools.

The Behavioral Health PLN will be convened four times during the 2019-2020 school year by Ready by 21 staff who will coordinate logistics for meetings and will secure experts to provide value on topics of mutual interest to participants.

Participants: *St. Louis County School district teams which could include student services leaders and district social workers (at district discretion), CSF-funded agency teams which could include executive directors, program directors and school-based services directors (at agency discretion).*
